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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: What is a Zero Waste Workshop?

A: A Zero Waste Workshop is an interactive educational workshop aimed at guiding participants how to manage waste sustainably at home and at work, with the aim of zero waste to landfill.

Q: Who can attend the workshop?

A: We can tailor the content based on the participants' profiles. Here are some examples:

- Company A wishes to build capabilities of appointed sustainability leads in the company.
- Company B wishes to offer a family-oriented CSR opportunity for employees to learn alongside their family members.
- Company C that wishes to sponsor training for other organizations (e.g. schools, NGOs)

From the above, you can see that the workshop is open to anyone interested in learning about waste reduction and sustainable living. This includes individuals, families, students, businesses, and community groups.

Q: What topics are covered in the workshop?

A: Topics will generally cover the following, subject to tailoring based on participants' profiles and requirements:

1. Introduction to Sustainability and Climate Change
2. Overview Singapore's decarbonization and sustainability efforts
3. Why is waste important?
4. What is Circular Economy and Zero Waste approach?
5. How can we transition to Circular Economy?
6. Circularity Challenge Sprint <group activity, 1hour>

Q: In what language the workshop will be conducted?

A: The workshop will be conducted in English.

Q: What can I expect to learn from the workshop?

A: Participants will be able to appreciate the importance of waste in sustainability and tackling climate change, gain insights into how organizations/people are implementing Zero Waste approaches, and kickstart your journey in Zero Waste.

Q: How long does the workshop last? What are the available dates? How many participants can take part?

A: The 3-hour workshop will be run on weekly Thursday from 2pm to 5pm. The number of participants are limited to 30 pax for the workshop to ensure quality delivery with actionable insights.
